

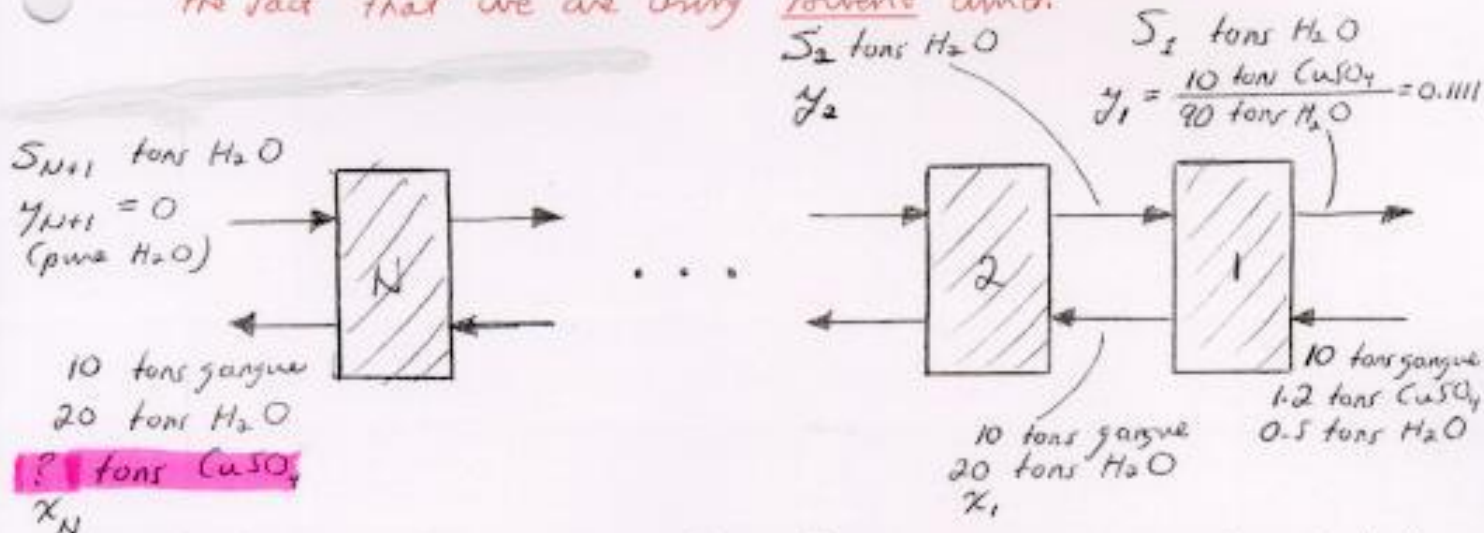
## PROBLEMS

- 23.1. Roasted copper ore containing the copper as  $\text{CuSO}_4$  is to be extracted in a counter-current stage extractor. Each hour a charge consisting of 10 tons of inert solids, 1.2 tons of copper sulfate, and 0.5 ton of water is to be treated. The strong solution produced is to consist of 90%  $\text{H}_2\text{O}$  and 10%  $\text{CuSO}_4$  by weight. The recovery of  $\text{CuSO}_4$  is to be 98 percent of that in the ore. Pure water is to be used as the fresh solvent. After each stage, 1 ton of inert solids retains 2 tons of water plus the copper sulfate dissolved in that water. Equilibrium is attained in each stage. How many stages are required?

"gangue" = insoluble rock 1

**Method (1):** use solvent amounts + mass ratio.

Notation  $S$  for amounts in overflow (V plane) emphasizes the fact that we are using solvent amounts.



I. Preliminaries and overall balances around entire extraction battery

Recover 98% of the  $\text{CuSO}_4$  in the ore  $\Rightarrow$

$$(1 - 0.98) \times 1.2 \text{ tons} = 0.024 \text{ tons } \text{CuSO}_4 \text{ remaining in exiting solid}$$

$$x_N = \frac{0.024 \text{ tons } \text{CuSO}_4}{20 \text{ tons } \text{H}_2\text{O}} = 0.0012$$

Note: 1 ton inert gangue retains 2 tons of  $\text{H}_2\text{O}$  (plus additional mass of dissolved  $\text{CuSO}_4$ ), not 2 tons of solution. This retention is independent of concentration of  $\text{CuSO}_4$  in the solution.

$\text{CuSO}_4$  balance:

$$\underbrace{1.2 + 0}_{\text{in}} = \underbrace{0.1111 S_1 + 0.024}_{\text{out}} \Rightarrow S_1 = 10.58 \text{ tons } \text{H}_2\text{O}$$

$\text{H}_2\text{O}$  balance:

$$\underbrace{0.5 + S_{N+1}}_{\text{in}} = \underbrace{S_1 + 20}_{\text{out}} \Rightarrow S_{N+1} = 30.08 \text{ tons } \text{H}_2\text{O}$$

II. Balances around first stage.

$$\text{Exiting streams at equilibrium} \Rightarrow x_1 = y_1 = 0.1111$$

$$\underbrace{0.5 + S_3}_{\text{in}} = \underbrace{20 + S_1}_{\text{out}} \Rightarrow S_2 = 30.08 \text{ tons H}_2\text{O}$$

↑  
same as  $S_{N+1}$ .

In fact  $S_{N+1}, S_N, \dots, S_3, S_2$  are all equal because water retention by gangue is independent of solution concentration.

CuSO<sub>4</sub> balance:

$$\underbrace{1.2 + S_2 y_2}_{\text{in}} = S_1 y_1 + x_1 (20) \Rightarrow y_2 = 0.0730$$

↑                    ↑                    ↑  
30.08 tons        10.58 tons        =  $y_1 = 0.1111$

Operating line between  $(x_1, y_2)$  and  $(x_N, y_{N+1})$  will be straight, because (i) H<sub>2</sub>O flow rates for liquid and solid phases are constant, and (ii) we use concentration variables in units of (retained H<sub>2</sub>O) tons CuSO<sub>4</sub> per ton H<sub>2</sub>O.

### III. Number of stages.

Going from stage 2 to N (i.e., NOT counting first stage), and using book notation,

$$\left\{ \begin{array}{l} y_b = y_{N+1} = 0 \\ x_b = x_N = 0.0012 \\ y_b^* = \text{liq. phase conc. in equil. with } x_b \\ \quad = x_b, \text{ because for leaching the equil. relation is } y=x. \\ \quad = 0.0012 \end{array} \right.$$

$$\left\{ \begin{array}{l} y_a = y_2 = 0.0730 \\ x_a = x_1 = 0.1111 \\ y_a^* = \text{liq. phase conc. in equil. with } x_a \end{array} \right.$$

From eq. (17-24) on p. 465,

$$N_{2 \rightarrow N} = \frac{\log \left( \frac{y_b - y_b^*}{y_a - y_a^*} \right)}{\log \left( \frac{y_b - y_a}{y_b^* - y_a^*} \right)} = \frac{\log \left( \frac{0 - 0.0012}{0.0730 - 0.1111} \right)}{\log \left( \frac{0 - 0.0730}{0.0012 - 0.1111} \right)}$$

$$= 8.45$$

(can also use eq. (17-27) on p. 466 - is mathematically equivalent)

Total number of ideal stages required = 1 + 8.45 = 9.45 ideal stages.

**Method 2** use solution amounts & mass fraction

**Composition-dependent retention of solution by rock**

| mass fraction $\text{CuSO}_4$ (x) | tons of solution retained per ton of (inert) rock |
|-----------------------------------|---|
| 0                                 | 2   |
| 0.005                             | 2.0101  |
| 0.01                              | 2.0202  |
| 0.05                              | 2.1053  |
| 0.1                               | 2.2222  |

Where do these numbers come from? Consider 1 ton of rock retaining solution with  $\text{CuSO}_4$  mass fraction x:

$$x = \frac{\text{CuSO}_4}{\text{CuSO}_4 + \text{water}} = \frac{Lx}{Lx + 2}$$

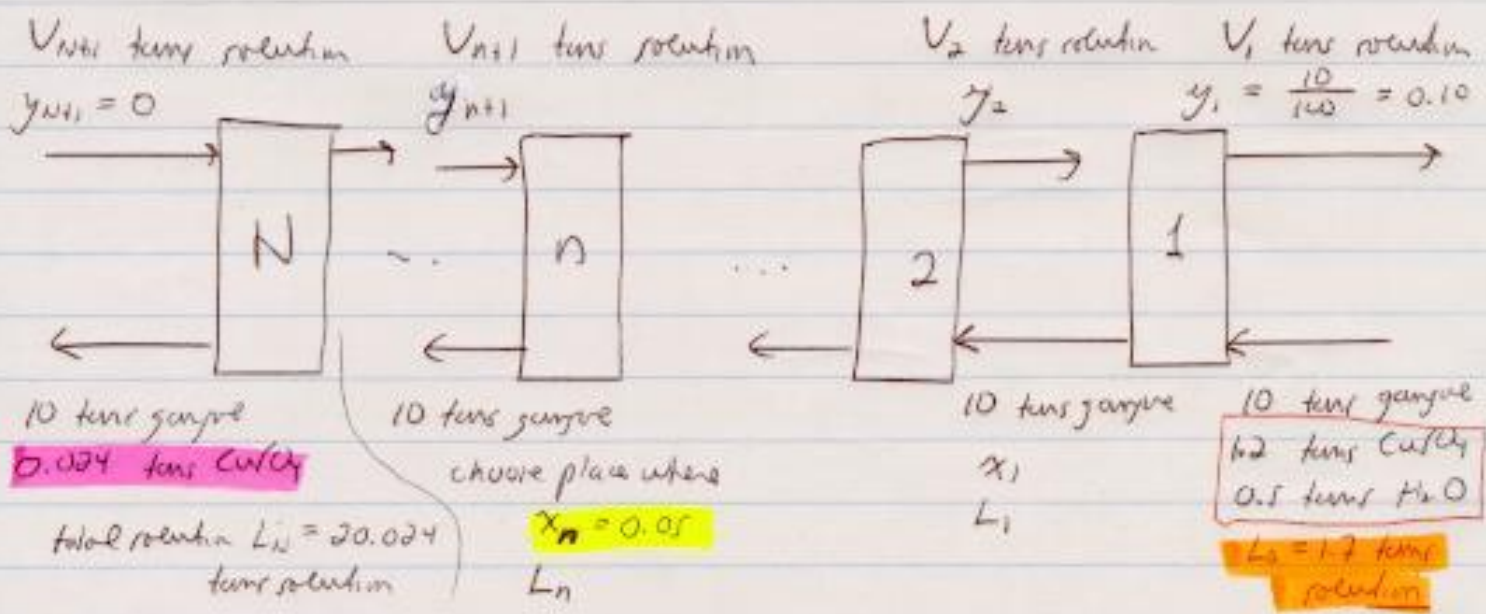
$L = \text{amt. of}$   
 1 ton of rock retains 2 tons of  $\text{H}_2\text{O}$  (+  $\text{CuSO}_4$  dissolved in it)

or  $1 = \frac{L}{Lx+2}$  or  $L = \frac{2}{1-x} =$  amt. of solution retained by one ton of rock

Now ready to solve problem.

I. Prelim. + overall balances

Guess  $x_N = 0.0012$ . Interpolate in table  $\Rightarrow$   
 1 ton of rock retains 2.0024 tons of solution  $\Rightarrow$   
 $L_N = (10 \text{ tons of rock}) (2.0024 \text{ tons solution/ton rock})$   
 $= 20.024 \text{ tons solution}$   
 $\Rightarrow x_N = \frac{0.024 \text{ tons CuSO}_4}{20.024 \text{ tons solution}}$   
 $= 0.0012$  same! guess good.



CuSO<sub>4</sub> balance:  $1.2 + 0 = \overset{0.10}{y_1} V_1 + 0.024$   
 $\Rightarrow V_1 = 11.760 \text{ tons solution}$

Solution balance:  $\underbrace{1.7 + V_{n+1}}_{in} = \underbrace{V_1 + 20.024}_{out}$  (11.760)

$\Rightarrow V_{n+1} = 30.084$  tons solution

II. Balance around 1<sup>st</sup> stage

from table

Equal:  $x_1 = y_1 = 0.10 \Rightarrow L_1 = (10)(2.2222) = 22.222$  tons solution

Solution balance:

$\underbrace{1.7 + V_2}_{in} = \underbrace{V_1 + L_1}_{out}$  (11.760)

$\Rightarrow V_2 = 30.222$  tons solution

Cu/0<sub>4</sub> balance:

$\underbrace{1.2 + y_2 V_2}_{in} = \underbrace{y_1 V_1 + x_1 L_1}_{out}$  (0.10) (11.760) (0.10) (22.222)  
 $\Rightarrow y_2 = 0.06809$

III. Intermediate point

Consider control vol. from right end of apparatus to point where  $x_n = 0.05$ . From table  $\Rightarrow$

$L_n = (10)(2.1053) = 21.053$  tons solution

Solution balance:

$\underbrace{1.7 + V_{n+1}}_{in} = \underbrace{V_1 + L_n}_{out}$  (11.760)

$\Rightarrow V_{n+1} = 31.113$  tons solution

Cu/0<sub>4</sub> balance:

$\underbrace{1.2 + y_{n+1} V_{n+1}}_{in} = \underbrace{y_1 V_1 + x_n L_n}_{out}$  (0.10) (11.760) (0.05) (21.053)

$\Rightarrow y_{n+1} = 0.03306$

IV. So:

$$\begin{aligned}(x_0, y_0) &= (0.7059, 0.1) \\(x_1, y_1) &= (0.1, 0.05209) \\&\vdots \\(x_n, y_n) &= (0.05, 0.03306) \\&\vdots \\(x_N, y_N) &= (0.0012, 0)\end{aligned}$$

Construct sp. diagram & count stages (next page)  
→ need  $\approx 10$  stages Same answer as by Method (1)!
